WARNING
NOTICE of VIOLATION
ANIMAL EXHIBITOR

Upon receipt of information in an email from the above named institution to the Division of Fish and Wildlife, Wildlife Permits Unit, it is determined that the above named institution has violated the conditions of its Animal Exhibitor Permit #EX 2020001 and the letter enclosed with the permit.

Per the Animal Exhibitor/Animal Theatrical permit enclosure letter sent via email with the original permit dated November 21, 2019, "Regulated exotic and nongame wildlife entering the state must have the appropriate, current health certificates to ensure that they do not pose a threat to human, native wildlife or agriculture, and that they are capable of performing as indicated in your application." The above named institution has indicated that several of the animals newly acquired at Seaquest Woodbridge, LLC did not have health certificates prior to entering the state, including amphibians and birds. Health certificates are required for all regulated species coming into New Jersey from other states.

This violation could carry a maximum penalty of \$25,000 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 23:2A-10 with each day being a separate offence and accruing a separate penalty if the violation is of a continuing nature.

This letter is a warning concerning the violations mentioned above and the following must be adhered to going forward in 2020 and for future years:

- 1. Health certificates must be acquired for all regulated mammals, reptiles, amphibians, and birds imported into the state and must be provided to the Wildlife Permits Unit at any time when requested.**

If the above named institution adheres to the above DURING 2020, this portion of the matter will be concluded.



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If, however, the conditions continue to be neglected, the Department may proceed against you as permitted by law and will seek penalties as defined in a Notice of Violation and possible revocation of permits.
