REGULATED WILDLIFE MUST BE IN DIRECT CONTROL OF SEAQUEST WOODBRIDGE LLC ANIMAL HANDLERS. THE ONLY PUBLIC CONTACT AUTHORIZED IS RESTRICTED TO THE SPECIES INDICATED ON THE WILDLIFE INVENTORY LIST ON THIS PERMIT AND MUST BE CONTROLLED AT ALL TIMES BY THE SEAQUEST WOODBRIDGE ANIMAL HANDLERS. THE PUBLIC MAY ONLY TOUCH THE BACK OF REGULATED SPECIES WITH TWO FINGERS WHEN THE ANIMAL IS IN CONTROL OF AUTHORIZED SEAQUEST WOODBRIDGE ANIMAL HANDLERS. REGULATED WILDLIFE MUST BE HELD BY THE HEAD AND TAIL AT ALL TIMES DURING AUTHORIZED INTERACTIONS.

Wildlife must be exhibited in such a manner as to prevent any possibility of public contact and/or escape. Wildlife Permits Unit must be notified a minimum of two weeks prior to any New Jersey Exhibition.

SeaQuest Woodbridge LLC must send a copy of all incident reports relating to animal inflicted injury to the public and staff to the Wildlife Permits Unit as soon as possible after said incident.

Wildlife Permits Unit must be notified a minimum of two weeks prior to any New Jersey Exhibition activities. Issued in conjunction with USDA CLASS "C" EXHIBITOR PERMIT, CERTIFICATE NUMBER 88-C-0216, CUSTOMER NUMBER 502434, EXPIRES NOVEMBER 27, 2019

- ❖ This permit is issued subject to inspection of premises and may be revoked at any time for violation.
 - ❖ The issuance of this permit shall not be deemed a waiver of any other requirements to be met by the permittee necessitated by provisions of any statute, rule, regulation, ordinance or order of any Federal, State or local agency or agencies.
 - ❖ The permittee shall notify the Wildlife Permits Unit a minimum of two weeks prior to any scheduled Animal Exhibitor activities in New Jersey covered by permit.
 - ❖ NO ADDITIONAL POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS WILDLIFE MAY BE ACQUIRED OR BROUGHT INTO THE STATE WITHOUT PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE WILDLIFE PERMITS UNIT.

- ❖ **POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS SPECIES AS LISTED IN N.J.A.C. 7:25-4.8 AND ALL REGULATED ANIMALS MAY NOT COME IN CONTACT WITH THE PUBLIC FOR ANY REASON AND MUST BE EXHIBITED OR USED IN A WAY THAT PREVENTS PUBLIC ACCESS.**
- ❖ **FEEDING OF AND PHOTOGRAPHS TAKEN WITH REGULATED EXOTIC AND NONGAME WILDLIFE IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**
- ❖ Unless prior written approval has been obtained from the Wildlife Permits Unit, the regulated wildlife for which this permit has been granted shall not be liberated in this State.
- ❖ The possession of Endangered Species as defined by N.J.A.C. 7:25-4.13 requires a separate additional New Jersey Endangered Species Permit.
- ❖ **THIS PERMIT MUST BE DISPLAYED IN A PROMINENT PLACE** and a copy must accompany any Animal Exhibitor activities with regulated wildlife.

The following are the only regulated species approved for interactions with the public. All other interactions with regulated species are prohibited unless written approval from the Division of Fish and Wildlife has been granted and stated on your current permit.

<u>SPECIES</u>	<u>INTERACTION</u>	<u>SCHEDULE</u>
❖ Various turtle species	Feeding via tube	Unscheduled feedings throughout the day
❖ Linnaeus's Two-toed Sloth	Feeding via tube	5-7min encounters 10x Mon-Sat, 8x Sun; maximum 68 encounters per week
❖ Asian Small-Clawed Otter	Feeding via tube	30min encounters 6x Mon-Sat, 8x Sun; maximum 40 encounters per week
❖ Various reptile species	Two-finger touch	Rotating touch interactions, max 2-3x per day; maximum 14-21 encounters per week per individual animal

ASSORTED TURTLE FEEDING STATIONS:

1. Feeding portals must be at a height reasonable for guests to reach and constructed in a way to prevent contact with the animals in the exhibit.
2. The husbandry team is responsible for diet regulation and must not exceed the daily allotment as determined by the quantity of the animals and the species profile.
3. Acorn containers will be distributed by a token operated machine, which will allow for portion control.
4. High traffic days will have smaller amounts of diet per container.

SLOTH ENCOUNTER:

1. Interactions between the Linnaeus's Two-Toed Sloth and guests will be limited to a fixed schedule with a maximum of 68 encounters per week.
2. The sloth must be kept behind the acrylic physical barriers at all time to prevent direct contact between the animal and the public.
3. Diet regulation will be paced with the timing of the scheduled encounters, which will mimic the animal's behavior in the wild.
4. If there are fewer interactions per day according to the allotted schedule, the sloth will have access to food.
5. Food will be portioned out to prohibit overfeeding.

OTTER ENCOUNTER:

1. Interactions between the Asian Small-Clawed Otter and guests will be limited to a fixed schedule with a maximum of 40 encounters per week.
2. The otter must be kept behind the acrylic physical barrier at all times to prevent direct contact between the animal and the public.
3. Diet regulation is based on the age and weight of the otter. Guests may offer a percentage of the diet per interaction, but may not exceed the daily allotment.
4. Guests may also put enrichment items through the feeding portal.

REGULATED REPTILE ENCOUNTER:

1. Guests may use two fingers to touch the animals' backs only while the regulated wildlife is in direct control of the SeaQuest animal handlers.
2. The head and tail of the animal must be controlled at all times by SeaQuest animal handlers during these interactions.
3. Each individual animal may not exceed 21 encounters per week.

PERMIT CONDITIONS:

1. The public may only interact with the species specifically mentioned above in the manner that is indicated, i.e., feeding portal or a two-finger touch. Two-finger touch **MAY ONLY** be along the animal's back while the regulated animal is in direct control by SeaQuest animal handlers. The head and tail of the animal must be controlled at all times during these interactions by the animal handler(s)
2. Authorized interactions for the above regulated species may not exceed the indicated weekly maximum encounters.
3. Insufficient guest feeding must be supplemented by additional evening feedings by the SeaQuest husbandry team. The amount in the supplemental feeding will be determined by the amount of food left in the "acorn" machines at close.
4. Feeding portals must be monitored by SeaQuest husbandry staff at all times to ensure items other than the allowed food are not put into the animals' exhibits.
5. Animal handlers and/or husbandry staff must remain with guests at all times during all approved interactions with regulated species to restrict direct contact. The public may not enter the enclosures of regulated species at any time for any reason.
6. Guests partaking in the otter encounter must stay with their group at all times while they are travelling through the back of house to get to the encounter area.
7. Interactions with regulated species is strictly limited to the turtle feedings, Linnaeus's two-toed sloth, Asian small-clawed otter, and various reptile species. Other interactions must have written approval from the Wildlife Permits Unit
8. All copies of incident reports relating to guest and employee injuries inflicted by a regulated species must be sent to the Wildlife Permits Unit. Copies of incident reports relating to regulated species injuries inflicted by employees must also be sent to the Wildlife Permits Unit.
