Dear Ms. Hill:

This is in response to your January 27, 2020, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request seeking:

- *Any and all applications, licenses, permits, complaints, investigative reports, internal communication, correspondence with other agencies and/or individuals, photos, and videos, whether electronic, or hard copy pertaining to, or relating to, SeaQuest Woodbridge in New Jersey between the dates of 10/1/2019 through present date in regard to Complaint AC20-075.*

Your request was received in this office on January 28, 2020, and assigned case number FOIA 2020-APHIS-02076-F.

On January 21, 2020, the Investigative and Enforcement Services (IES) program office began a search of their records. IES did not find responsive records for this request. There were no investigation reports such as final actions, consent decisions, decision and orders, settlement agreements, stipulations nor tickets.

In addition on February 7, 2020, the Animal Care (AC) program began a search of their records. AC located fifteen pages of records responsive to your FOIA request.

The records requested are contained in a Privacy Act system of records. See, [APHIS-8: Veterinary Services - Animal Welfare](#). Generally, under the Privacy Act, an agency shall not disclose information contained in a system of records, except pursuant to the written request by or consent of the individual to whom the record pertains, unless an exception applies. There are twelve exceptions under the Privacy Act to this general prohibition to disclosure. See 5 U.S.C. § 552a (b). One exception authorizes disclosure when the FOIA requires the release of information contained in a system of records. *Id.* at § 552a (b)(2). After a review of these records, it has been determined that the documents will be released to you in part, pursuant to FOIA Exemptions 4, 6, 7(C) and 7(D).

Please be advised: There were no photographs or videos associated with this FOIA request. The Animal Welfare Act (AWA) complaint AC20-076 has not been resolved.

FOIA Exemption 4

FOIA Exemption 4 permits the government to withhold “trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person that is privileged or confidential.” *See 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(4)*. In order to determine whether certain information is exempt from release, APHIS must first establish that the information is commercial or financial and that it was obtained from a person, company, organization, state government, or other outside entity. Next APHIS must establish that the information is “confidential,” which means that the information is of the type not ordinarily or actually released by the submitter (hereinafter referenced as “CBI”). If the government provided assurances that such information to be submitted by a person will be kept confidential, then that assurance may provide additional, although not independently sufficient, ground for applying Exemption 4.

In this case, we are withholding information in the records that details financial information obtained by the individual submitters. The information is submitted as part of APHIS’s application for renewal license and regulatory process. In addition, we are withholding: the fee amounts for licensing; estimates of the total number of animals being purchased and sold in the next business year; and the estimate dollar amount of which the fee is based. These items are commercial and/or financial information. This is confidential information that is not ordinarily or actually released. As a result of the customarily confidential treatment of financial information, the information is exempt from release under FOIA Exemption 4.

FOIA Exemptions 6 & 7(C)

FOIA Exemption 6 permits the government to withhold from “personnel and medical files and similar files” information about individuals when the disclosure of such information “would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.” *See 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6)*. FOIA Exemption 7(C), which is the law enforcement counterpart to Exemption 6, permits the government to withhold information compiled for law enforcement purposes about individuals when the disclosure of such information “could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.” *See 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(7)(C)*. We have determined that the records at issue in this case meets the definition of “similar” files because they contain information pertaining to individual(s). Additionally, because APHIS is authorized under the Animal Welfare Act (AWA), (*see 7 U.S.C. §§ 2131-2159*), its inspection process is an administrative enforcement action, which is considered a law enforcement purpose covered under Exemption 7.

In order to determine whether documents, or portions thereof, may be withheld under Exemption 6 and 7(C), an agency must undertake a three-step analysis. First, the agency must determine whether a significant privacy interest would be compromised by the disclosure of the records. Second, the agency must determine whether the release of the document would further the public interest by shedding light on the operations and activities of the Government. And third, the agency must balance the

identified privacy interests against the public interest in disclosure. The purpose for which the request for information is made does not impact this balancing test because a release of information requested under the FOIA constitutes a release to the general public.

In this matter, we are withholding certain information from Inspection Reports; Animal Welfare Act Complaints; Correspondence and Renewal Applications such as signatures of owner. In addition, we are withholding information relating to the third-party individuals and a complainant's name and email address. The signatures have more than a *de minimis* privacy interest because revealing signatures could lead to identity theft and/or a forged signature. We have determined that this information far outweighs any public interest. The release of the signatures will not shed any light on APHIS activities or the performance of its statutory duties. Finally, because the harm to personal privacy is greater than any minimal public interest that may be served by disclosure, release of this personal information about would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of the privacy of the individuals. Therefore, the information is being withheld pursuant to FOIA exemptions 6 and 7(C).

Exemption 7(D)

FOIA Exemption 7(D) provides protection for "records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes [which] could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of a confidential source, including a state, local, or foreign agency or authority of any private institution which furnished information on a confidential basis, and, in the case of a record or information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source."

The goal of Exemption 7(D) is to protect the ability of law enforcement agencies to obtain information and cooperation from individuals who expect a degree of confidentiality as otherwise, they may be less likely to come forward in future investigations. In this case, we have withheld the identity of the confidential source and any information that would reveal the source's identity. In this instance, the confidential source voluntarily provided to our Agency information that could be used in an administrative law enforcement investigation with the understanding that their identity would remain confidential.

If you are not satisfied with this response, you may submit an administrative appeal. During the pandemic, our offices are closed. Instead of physically mailing your appeal, we ask that in the short term you submit your appeals electronically by email to FOIA.MRP.Appeals@usda.gov. Your appeal must be electronically transmitted within 90 days of the date of this response. Please reference case number 2020-APHIS-02076-F and the phrase "FOIA APPEAL" in the subject line of your email. To assist the Administrator in reviewing your appeal, please provide specific reasons why you believe modification of this determination is warranted.

Results: A focused inspection was conducted on January 7th 2020. The complainant voiced concern for the welfare of the animals on exhibit. At the time of inspection, the animals did not show any signs or behaviors that indicated distress. The animals were responsive to the people visiting the facility, animal caretakers and facility representatives and inspectors. Animals appeared to be in good physical condition. A training session was observed for the prehensile tail porcupines and the kinkajou. The animals were responsive to the animal caretakers and participated in target training session. The complainant alleged that during their visit to the facility a goat was licking an outlet. At the time of the focused inspection, there were no goats on exhibit at the facility and the exhibit that once housed the goats was empty. The goats were no longer present at the facility. The facility does have animal encounters for visitors. At the time of inspection, visitors were allowed inside the enclosure of the iguanas and the aviary for the birds. An easily identifiable employee were located within both these enclosures. Visitors were allowed to feed pigs with food provided by the facility. An easily identifiable employee was present to make sure that guests put the food into the bowls of the pigs. At the time of inspection the enclosures appeared to be in good structural condition. The enclosures were clean and free from excessive feces or debris. The size of the enclosures were adequate in size and allowed for normal postural adjustments.
