- The licensee must maintain a register of all approved projects and be able to identify current projects covered by this licence.
- The licensee must establish and maintain a method of ensuring any person who is to be involved in the conduct of an approved project under the licence has the appropriate veterinary skills for that project.
- The licensee must provide a copy of the Animal Use Report (including the annual statement from the relevant Animal Ethics Committee (AEC) indicating compliance with the Scientific Use Code for that year) to the CEO of the Department by 30 April of the year following the reporting period.
- The licensee must undertake an External Review in relation to its scientific use of animals in WA in accordance with the Scientific Use Code.
- Within 120 calendar days of the end of the period under review, unless otherwise approved in writing by the CEO, the licensee must provide the CEO of the Department with a copy of:
 - the External Review panel's final report;
 - the AEC's response to the External Review panel's final report (which is to be provided to the licensee); and
 - the licensee's response to
 - the final External Review report; and
 the AEC's response to that report.

- The CEO of the Department must be notified in writing of all changes to the structure of the AEC within 30 days of the changes being made.

Examples of changes to be notified include:

- Retirement or resignation of existing members
 - Appointment of new members, and
 - Reappointment of an existing member to a different category of membership.
- This licence applies at any facilities and/or places within WA at which animals are used by the scientific establishment for scientific purposes as long as the CEO is advised in writing of the location of the facilities and/or places and the start and end dates of activities there prior to the commencement of those activities.

CONDITIONS ON USE LICENCES ISSUED BEFORE 2019

The use of animals for scientific purposes under this licence is subject to the licence conditions imposed by the Animal Welfare Act 2002 and regulations, and to the additional conditions also set out below:

1. The licensee must maintain a register of all approved projects and be able to identify current projects covered by this licence.
2. The licensee must establish and maintain a method of ensuring any person who is to be involved in the conduct of an approved project under the licence has the appropriate veterinary skills for that project.
3. The licensee is to provide the chief executive officer of the Department with an annual statement from the relevant AEC indicating compliance with the scientific use code for that year. [Regulation 6(a), Animal Welfare (Scientific Purposes) Regulations 2003]
4. The licensee is to provide the chief executive officer of the Department with such relevant details in relation to the licence (including the annual Animal Use Report), as are requested by the chief executive officer of the Department from time to time. [Regulation 6(b), Animal Welfare (Scientific Purposes) Regulations 2003]
5. The licensee must undertake an External Review in relation to their scientific use of animals in Western Australia, in accordance with the Scientific Use Code. The period between External Reviews must not exceed three years (the period under review). The period under review must commence immediately following the last period under review. The commencement and end of the period under review must be stated in the review.
6. The licensee must provide a copy of;
 - the External Review panel's final report;
 - the AEC's response to the final External Review report (which is to be provided to the licensee); and
 - the licensee's response to
 - the final External Review report; and
 - the AEC's response to that report,to the Department within 120 calendar days of the end of the period under review, unless approved in writing by the chief executive officer of the Department.
7. The licensee must provide a copy of the Animal Use Report to the Department by 30th April of the year following the reporting period
8. Any changes to the details included on the application form for a licence to use or supply animals for scientific purposes are to be provided by the licensee to scientific.licensing@agric.wa.gov.au within 14 days of the change occurring.
9. This licence applies to the facility/facilities located at:
 - (i) Other places throughout the State. These locations and start and end dates must be disclosed to a scientific inspector (scientific.licensing@agric.wa.gov.au) prior to the commencement of any work under this licence. The Scientific Use Code means – the prescribed code of practice for the care and use of animals for scientific purposes. The latest edition of the “Australian code of practice for the care and use of animals for scientific purposes” (including any amendments) published from time to time by, or on behalf of, the National Health and Medical Research Council is prescribed as the “scientific use code”. [Section 5 Animal Welfare Act 2002 and Regulation 2 of the Animal Welfare (Scientific Purposes) Regulations 2003].
